

# **Scripture Reading**

2 Corinthians 6: 1-18

**6** We then, *as* workers together *with Him* also plead with *you* not to receive the grace of God in vain. <sup>2</sup> For He says: "In an acceptable time I have heard you, And in the day of salvation I have helped you."

Behold, now *is* the accepted time; behold, now *is* the day of salvation.

<sup>3</sup>We give no offense in anything, that our ministry may not be blamed. <sup>4</sup> But in all *things* we commend ourselves as ministers of God: in much patience, in tribulations, in needs, in distresses, <sup>5</sup> in stripes, in imprisonments, in tumults, in labors, in sleeplessness, in fastings; <sup>6</sup> by purity, by knowledge, by longsuffering, by kindness, by the Holy Spirit, by sincere love, <sup>7</sup> by the word of truth, by the power of God, by the armor of righteousness on the right hand and on the left, <sup>8</sup> by honor and dishonor, by evil report and good report; as deceivers, and yet true; <sup>9</sup> as unknown, and yet well known; as dying, and behold we live; as chastened, and yet not killed: <sup>10</sup> as sorrowful, yet always rejoicing; as poor, vet making many rich; as having nothing, and vet possessing all things.

<sup>11</sup> O Corinthians! We have spoken openly to you, our heart is wide open. <sup>12</sup> You are not restricted by us, but you are restricted by your *own* affections. <sup>13</sup> Now in return for the same (I speak as to children), you also be open.
<sup>14</sup> Do not be unequally yoked together with unbelievers. For what fellowship has righteousness with lawlessness? And what communion has light with darkness? <sup>15</sup> And what accord has Christ with Belial? Or what part has a believer with an unbeliever? <sup>16</sup> And what agreement has the temple of God with idols? For you are the temple of the living God. As God has said:

> I will dwell in them And walk among *them*. I will be their God, And they shall be My people." <sup>17</sup> Therefore "Come out from among them And be separate, says the Lord. Do not touch what is unclean, And I will receive you." <sup>18</sup> "I will be a Father to you,

And you shall be My sons and daughters, Says the LORD Almighty."
